## OBJECTIVES:

---

- Disseminate the educational approaches of the NHSM among multipliers in the member states where the campaign is ongoing
- Disseminate Bookmarks, and develop educators' competences in using it with young people
- Associate this target group to the campaign, by training them to be active in the NHSM through education.

- Departure day is 08.04.2022 check-out before 12:00.

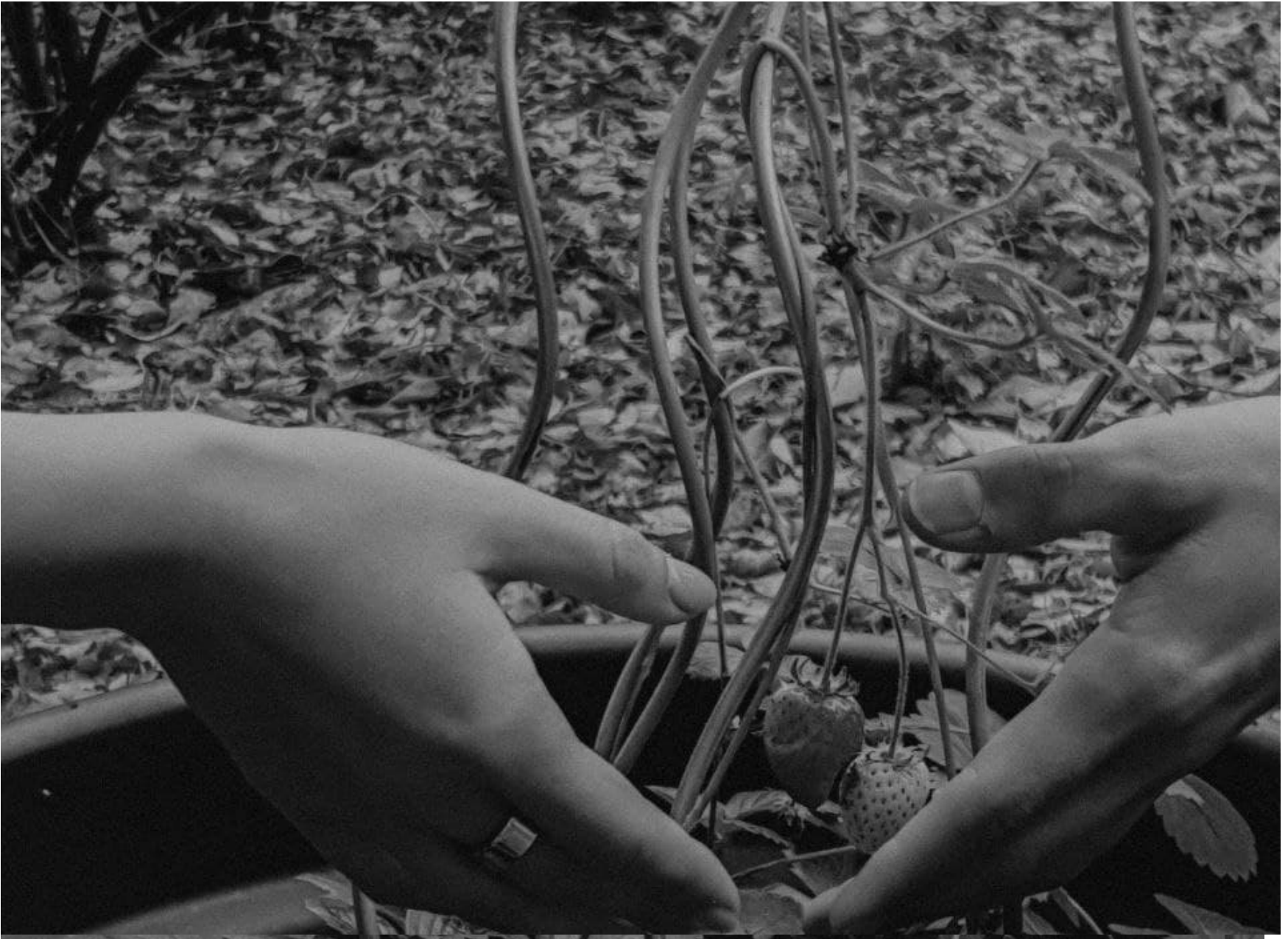
**PLEASE BOOK YOUR TICKETS BACK AFTER 12:00!!!** as it will take time for transfer to travel from the venue to Budapest

# FINANCIAL CONDITIONS



Full board and the lodging cost will be covered for all participants by the programme Erasmus +

NOTE THAT accommodation and meals will be provided ONLY for the period of the training course, starting from dinner 1st of April and finishing with breakfast 9th of April.

# Important information

You are expected to participate in all the activities, unless you are ill.

Unauthorized absence from activities and workshops is not permitted if less than 90% of the program is attended, it will not be possible to be reimbursed for the travel cost

In order to receive your reimbursement, please get your flight pre-approved by the coordinating organization from your country before booking!

Please keep all the original receipts and boarding passes. Without them we will not be able to reimburse your travels!

It is possible to come two days earlier before the project or/and leave two days after the project ended. This is at your own expense. This way we will still be able to reimburse your tickets, but extra nights and food will not be reimbursed for those extra days.

## WITH THE EU DIGITAL COVID CERTIFICATE

The EU Digital COVID Certificate is equivalent to the immunity certificate recognised by Hungary. Persons presenting the EU Digital COVID Certificate can enter Hungary without restrictions.

# **WITHOUT THE EU DIGITAL COVID CERTIFICATE**

---

Please note, that foreign passengers without a valid EU Digital Covid Certificate, previous infection or immunity certificate issued by specific countries, can only enter Hungary for essential travel after applying for an exemption [here](#).

The essential entry documents will have to be presented to the ground handling agents or border/health authorities at the airport, before embarking your flight.

Furthermore, several countries demand additional prerequisites. We will send you a separate notification with more details in case it is relevant for you.

Please note it is your sole responsibility to be familiar with the relevant travel regulations and restrictions, ensure you are eligible to enter Hungary and are fit to travel.
