Project objectives:

We are going to gain tools stimulating more compassionate, non-violent communication between young people, which would consequently lead to reducing the potential for violence and radicalisation among them.

Objectives of the project:

- To equip youth workers and leaders with the tools of conflict transformation and non-violent communication
- To promote conscious and non-violent behavior among participants with the use of nonformal education methods to be afterwards applied in their workplaces with young people
- To get acquainted with the situation of conflict transformation in the participating countries and make the exchange of best practices
- To form a network among like-minded organisations and develop follow-up projects within the project topic



Conditions of participation

- Age: 18 +
- Young leaders, youth workers, teachers, educators, students
- 3 participants per country
- Interest in the topic and ideas/methods to contribute to the programme
- Working language - English
- Participants with fewer opportunities are prioritized
- Full-time involvement in the programme

The project is funded by Erasmus + Programme through German NA. The accommodation, food, exchange activities will be covered by the organizers.



Venue

The project will be held in Berlin at the hostel "*Seminarhaus Weissensee*".

The address to get there: *Indira-Gandhi-Straße 13, 13088 Berlin*. You will be accommodated with participants of the same gender in 4-8bed rooms. Bed-linen and towels will be provided.

Within non-formal education we foster community based living, so please be prepared to take care of your space making it clean and nice (no room services will be provided).

You will have 3 times vegetarian meal during the day: breakfast, lunch and dinner. *Breakfasts will be made by participants on beforehand agreed schedule of 2-3 ppl per day.*

Important - It is not allowed to drink alcohol in the hostel.



Travel budget

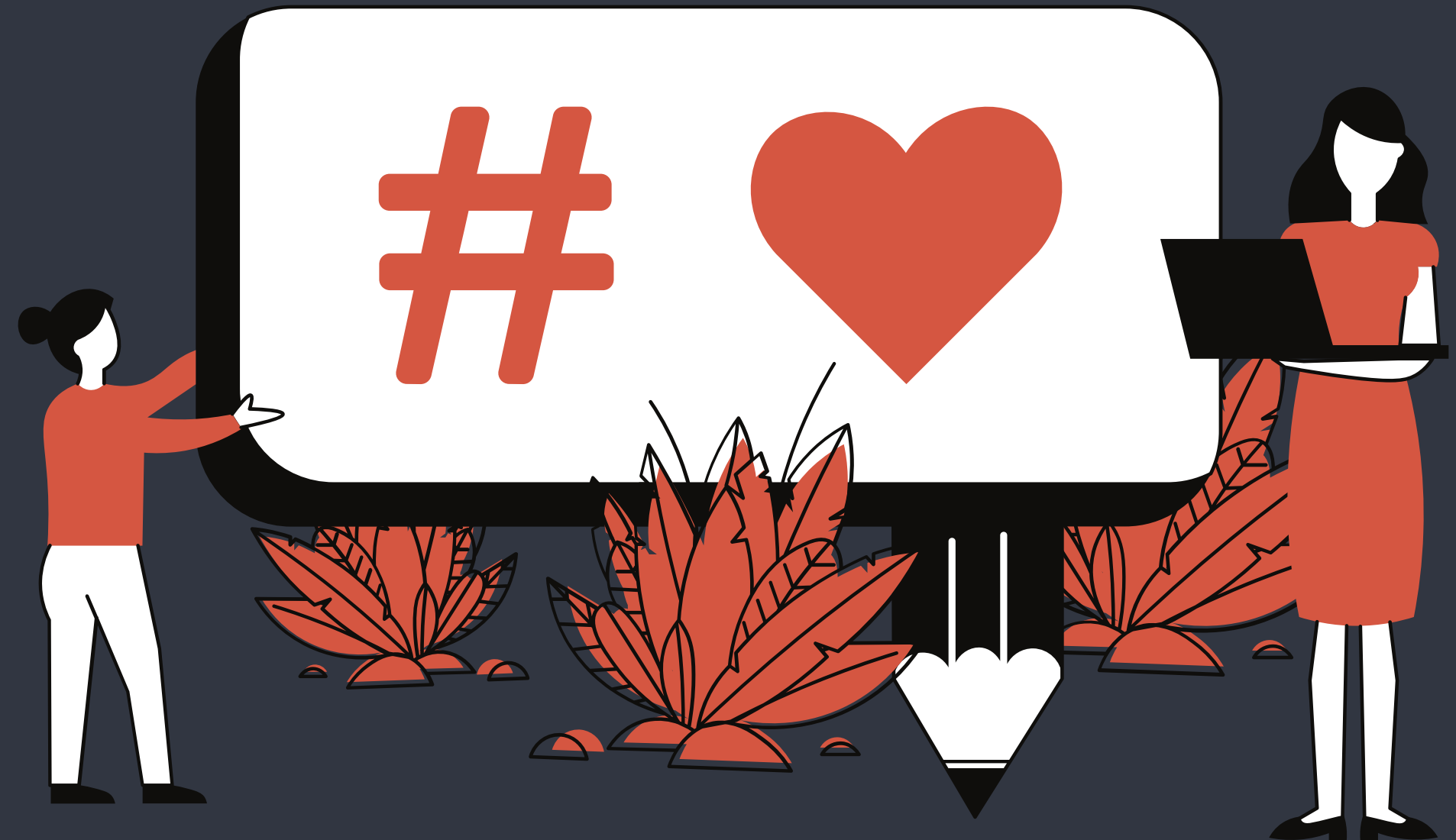
Travel costs (airplane):

- Germany – max. 180 Euro;
- Italy, Netherlands, Latvia – max. 275 Euro;
- Portugal – max.530 Euro;
- Armenia, Georgia - max. 360 Euro.

Travel costs can be higher, in case if you choose green travel with low-emissions means of transport for the main part of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling. In this case travel costs will be:

- Germany – max. 210 Euro;
- Italy, Netherlands, Latvia – max. 320 Euro;
- Portugal – max. 610 Euro;
- Armenia, Georgia - max. 410 Euro.

Do not buy any tickets without the approval of your travel plan by the project organiser.



Arrival and Departure



Arrival day is 06.02.2023, check - in 16:00, departure day is 15.02.2023 checkout 10:00. It is possible to arrive and depart 2 days before and after the project if you can prove that the flights were cheap on these days (a screenshot is required). If you arrive earlier or depart later you have to take care of your accommodation and food on your own.

NOTE: Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon full attendance of the project. It will either be transferred to private accounts after receiving all the tickets and filling in the reimbursement form or will be given in cash on the last project day.
